



Five Star Equestrian Interscholastic Equestrian Association Guidelines & Information

Registration

1. Go online to rideiea.org and click on "Membership" tab
2. Complete the "Rider" application" & print it out (Team Name is *Five Star Equestrian*)
 - a. Don't worry about classes - we will enter the level in for you
3. Make sure to also print your proof of payment before you exit registration or get copy in your email inbox
4. Rider and parent/guardian **BOTH** need to sign the form in the lower right hand corner
5. Turn in your registration form with your proof of payment to us – we will complete the process (do not mail in your form)
 - a. It takes up to 15 days to add a rider, so please do this as soon as possible
 - b. Please email me a scanned version of the signed rider application & proof of payment so that I can complete the registration process

Costs and Fees (Not regular Five Star Clients)

- \$660/season for 10 lessons (includes team practices)
- \$40/class at shows
- Trainer Expenses & Fees at shows (depends on number of participants & location of show, local shows cost less than away shows that require hotel accommodations – all will be split amount competitors)
 - A minimum coaching fee of \$150 is charged for each day of a show and split among competitors – this amount does not include trainer expenses
 - When our team is co-hosting or hosting a show, team members will split any costs associated with hosting the show (i.e. stall fees, haul in fees, judge's fees, etc.)
- \$35/meet set up fee – at home team practices (these are in lieu of lessons that week)
- Five Star team jacket and polo

Costs and Fees (Five Star Clients)

- \$40/class at shows
- Trainer Expenses & Fees at shows (depends on number of participants & location of show, local shows cost less than away shows that require hotel accommodations – all will be split amount competitors)
 - A minimum coaching fee of \$150 is charged for each day of a show and split among competitors – this amount does not include trainer expenses
 - When our team is co-hosting or hosting a show, team members will split any costs associated with hosting the show (i.e. stall fees, haul in fees, judge's fees, etc.)
- \$35/meet set up fee – at home team practices (these are in lieu of lessons that week) – this fee is waived if those who own or full lease a horse loan them to be used at practice meet
- Five Star team jacket and polo

Fundraising

Teams can make money to cover the cost of hosting shows and/or for away shows by selling food at hosted shows. Breakfast is always free, but lunch can be sold throughout the show.

Team Parents

A parent from each team (middle school and high school) will be asked to help with registration of team members, collection of payments and releases for shows, sending in completed entries for shows, spear heading fundraisers, etc.

Team Captains

Each team (middle school and high school) will vote for one member to be the team captain. The role of team captain is to keep other team members aware of when there will be practice meets and/or shows, follow up to be sure everyone arrives on time, develop fundraising ideas and motivate team members to participate in fundraising, etc.
