



FIVE STAR EQUESTRIAN SHOWTEAM SHOW FEES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

When clients travel to shows, additional expenses will accompany the class fees. The list below includes many, but not all of the expenses. Five Star Equestrian requires that all accounts be settled prior to departure from show (Show Accounts & Five Star Equestrian accounts). ***We reserve the right to add a \$25 penalty fee if a show invoice is not settled upon receipt.***

NOTE: We may not take a horse if hauling hasn't been paid by at least one day prior to departure when applicable.

Show fees include, but are not limited to:

- Five Star Equestrian Show Fees (see below)
- Fee per class (depends on show: \$40-50/class regular classes, \$75-100/class specialty classes, higher fees may apply)
- Class fees on trainer classes on Wednesday and/or Thursday of show (trainers will take horses into classes to prep them for clients – these classes will be on client show bills at the show office)
- Grounds Nominating Fee (non-refundable)
- Grounds Schooling Fees (non-refundable)
- Stall Fee (non-refundable)
- USEF Fees (\$8/USEF horse + \$8/drug fee; \$30/rider USEF non-member + \$30/rider USHJA non-members)

Show Fees Charged by Five Star Equestrian:

Trainer Fee/Showteam*	\$90/day/horse (owner/full lease only)
Trainer Fee/Half Lease	\$100/day/horse
Trainer Fee for 2 nd Horse	\$60/day/horse (if rider is showing two horses, 2 nd horse fee applies to 2 nd horse only)
Trainer Fee - shared Horse	\$60 - split with other rider
Trainer Expenses	\$TBD/client (split among all competitors: hotel, food, transportation)
Groom Fee	\$75/day/horse paid in cash (Please remember to tip grooms)
Show Set Up Fees	\$100/horse (Tent set up/tear down, show coordination, organization of horse feeding/care during show, etc.)
Flowers/Grass	\$TBD/split per horse
Hauling**	\$TBD (depends on hauler and distance of show)
Braiding (mane/tail)	\$TBD (depends on service provider used – approx. \$165)
Tack Stall & Groom Stall	\$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under “trainer split”)
Schooling Classes	\$TBD/horse (Trainers will show in 1-2 classes on Wednesday and/or Thursday for prep)
Hay/bedding Fee	\$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under “trainer split”)
Misc. Show Fee	\$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under “trainer split”)
Golf Cart Split (per rider)	\$TBD (if not included on show office invoice under “trainer split”)
Show Equipment Packing	\$75 (if trunks not ready on day of departure fee will apply)
Tack Trunk Rental	\$100/week

TIPS: Minimum amounts for Groom \$120-140/week per horse, Asst. Trainer \$80/week per horse payable in cash

DEPOSIT DUE: \$500/show non-refundable (To be paid to FSE 30 days in advance of show dates)
Hauling to be paid prior to departure to the show.

CANCELLATION: Show Managers reserve the right to charge up to 100% of Stall and other fees. This will be the responsibility of the client if cancellation occurs after entry has been submitted.

LATE REGISTRATION: If commitment to show is not made 60 days prior to show date, a late registration fee of \$150 may apply (not credited to Five Star show bill) in addition to the \$500 non-refundable deposit (will show as credit on Five Star show bill).

*Show-Team Members either own or full lease a horse.

**Payments for hauling may be due prior to departure or may be included on your show invoice.
