

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

When clients travel to shows, additional expenses will accompany the class fees. The list below includes many, but not all of the expenses. We ask that show invoices are paid upon receipt in order to avoid late fees.

Show fees include, but are not limited to:

- Five Star Equestrian Show Fees (see below)
- Fee per class (depends on show: \$40-50/class regular classes, \$75-100/class specialty classes, higher fees may apply)
- Class fees on trainer classes on Wednesday and/or Thursday of show (trainers will take horses into classes to prep them for clients – these classes will be on client show bills at the show office)
- Grounds Nominating Fee (non-refundable)
- Grounds Schooling or Arena Fees (non-refundable)
- Stall Fee (non-refundable)
- USEF Fees may include: Horse fee, Drug fee; \$30/rider, USEF non-member, \$30/rider USHJA non-members, etc.

Trainer Fee/Showteam* \$90/day/horse (owner/full lease only)

Trainer Fee/Non-Showteam \$150/day/horse

Trainer Fee for 2nd Horse \$60/day/horse (if rider is showing two horses, 2nd horse fee applies to 2nd horse only)

Trainer Fee - shared Horse \$90/rider

Trainer Expenses \$TBD/client (split among all competitors: cargo trailer, hotel, food, transportation)

Groom Fee \$TBD/day/horse* paid in cash – rate depends on groom

(Groom Fee is currently \$95/day/horse - includes tip – amount/day depends on groom)

Groom Hotel \$TBD (split between all competitors: depends on Show Grounds)

Show Set Up Fees \$150/horse (Tent set up/tear down, show coordination, organization of horse feeding/care

during show, etc.)

BioSecurity Paperwork \$15/horse (plus any associated veterinary fees)

Flowers/Grass \$TBD/split per horse

Calming Supplement/Meds \$TBD (Perfect Prep, NSAIDS, Methocarbamol, etc. – depends on horse and needs)

Hauling \$TBD (depends on hauler and distance of show)

Payment for hauling may be due prior to departure or included in your FSE show invoice

Braiding (mane/tail) \$TBD (depends on service provider used – approx. \$165)

Tack Stall & Groom Stall \$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under "trainer split")

Schooling Classes \$TBD/horse (Trainers will show in 1-2 classes on Wednesday and/or Thursday for prep)

Hay/bedding Fee \$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under "trainer split")

Misc. Show Fee \$TBD/horse (if not included on show office invoice under "trainer split")

Golf Cart Split (per rider) \$TBD (if not included on show office invoice under "trainer split")

Show Equipment Packing \$75 (if trunks not ready on day of departure fee will apply)

Large Equipment Rental \$200/week if available (note: includes, but not limited to: tack trunks, saddles and bridles)

ASST TRAINER: Minimum for Assistant Trainer \$80/week per horse

DEPOSIT DUE: \$1,000/show non-refundable**. Will be due and collected on any rider who cancels a show within

90 days of the start date of the show.

CANCELLATION**: Show Managers reserve the right to charge up to 100% of Stall and other fees. This will

be the responsibility of the client if cancellation occurs after entry has been submitted.

**Additional fees that may apply if a rider cancels within 90 days of a show include, but are not limited to, groom fee, hauling deposit, trainer fee and/or trainer split. Grooms, haulers and participants are provided with a specific number of horses in advance and if a rider cancels within

90 days, payment may be required in spite of absence.

LATE REGISTRATION: If commitment to show is not made 90 days prior to show date, a late registration fee of

\$150 may apply (not credited to Five Star show bill) in addition to the \$1,000 non-refundable fee (will show as credit on Five Star show bill, if paid in advance).
